Developing a new program

Running a successful software and app development company isn't all that different from playing a professional sport. As Atimi has learned through servicing clients across the NHL, MLS, and NBA, people in the technology world also have to worry about staying on their toes, keeping their eyes on the ball, and being in tune with fellow players.

With scores of development projects and client presentations on the Atimi docket, it's critical for the company's 120-person staff to maintain clear communication and organization. Unfortunately, the file management system Atimi had in place wasn't built to keep up with a fast-paced, collaborative environment. Often, files would be edited by more than one person, causing all involved parties to have to stop what they were doing and compare versions to figure out who had done what, and when. Accessing the file management system was also problematic, as not everyone in the company shared the same level of technical expertise and the system required users to "check in" and "check out" every time they wanted to view a file.

The team needed an easier solution that could provide more control over file versions and more flexible access. After evaluating options, Atimi chose to set up a Dropbox for Business account. "On our custom engineering side, we have a product design group that moves very quickly, with no time to spend talking about which version of a file is the correct one," says Michaels. "Dropbox definitely helps us work more efficiently."

In addition to the desktop solution, the Dropbox for Business mobile application has become a favorite among Atimi employees. Sales representatives regularly pull up presentations and other client-facing materials right on their iPhones and iPads when they're working remotely. As Suryam explains, "There have been a number of times when I've been traveling and used the Dropbox app to look over files for people back in the office. It's handy — I can do it all right from my phone. And it's so much better than having to deal with email or VPN."

The right focus

With a workforce distributed between Canada and India, simplified remote access to files is invaluable to Atimi employees who travel and telecommute. "The best thing about having Dropbox for Business is how it gives us

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the ability to work away from the office," Suryam attests. "Even if employees are traveling, you get a notification on Dropbox when they've updated a document, so you can see what they've done immediately."

Atimi's IT team has also been positively impacted by Dropbox for Business. Not only has Dropbox proven less expensive than other software, servers, and licenses, it requires less time and effort for the IT team to support. The team was even able to save themselves and other users the hassle of having to set up new Dropbox passwords, as they used the Dropbox API to integrate Atimi's existing authentication process.
